PUBLIC LECTURE SERIES: KYLE EASTMAN

Montana Tech's Public Lecture Series will host Kyle Eastman, Economic Geologist with the Montana Bureau of Mines & Geology, on **Thursday, February 9** at 4:00 pm in the Copper Lounge. Eastman's presentation is titled, *The Critical Minerals Problem: Finding the Materials our Society Needs.* Kyle is an economic geologist at the Montana Bureau of Mines and Geology and conducts field-based critical mineral prospectivity studies. He received a M.Sc. in Geosciences from Montana Tech in 2017, and studied the supergene mineralogy of the Continental Pit as well as Pb-Zn-Ag carbonate replacement deposits and naturally occurring acid rock drainage. Kyle's research interests include magmatic-hydrothermal ore systems and supergene processes, and he has worked on porphyry-epithermal-skarn projects in Australia, Indonesia, and South America. Kyle is a passionate mineral collector and enjoys mountain biking and rock climbing.
