RESTORATION SEMINAR

The restoration seminar this week will be presented by Paul Helfrich, who will discuss his

ongoing dissertation research. He studies the most fundamental aspects of Silver Bow Creek using an integrated metagenomic and geochemical sampling protocol to help answer questions about the ongoing status of restoration in Silver Bow Creek. He will discuss changes in the geochemistry of the creek, the importance of interdisciplinary cooperation, and the microorganisms that call the area home. The presentation will take place on **October 4** in CBB 101 or Zoom (passcode: Seminar).

MONTANA TECH MINERAL INDUSTRY SYMPOSIUM
